A Reflection on the Gospel based on an extract from: An extract from *Salt of the Earth, Light of the World, a Spirituality of the Sunday Gospels*, Year A by Peter Varengo, pp. 37-40.

We Are Family

As we stand at the intersection between the closure of a year and the beginning of a new on... Our Christmas liturgy today invites us to look again at the stable of Bethlehem but this time from the perspective of the displaced family of Nazareth, and there discover who we are and what we are meant to be, as individuals and as members of a human family.

God chose to enter human history through the flesh and blood of an ordinary human family, so ordinary that from the beginning Jesus' own kin and towns folks alike refused to acknowledge and/or accept him as anyone except the son of the village carpenter (Matthew 13:55-57).

Somehow Jesus' contemporaries could not accept a God so enmeshed into the human reality as to be one of them. That was the original challenge of God's revelation in Jesus, through the ordinary and daily. The grandeur and omnipotence of God is never otherworldly but becomes incarnate in the ordinariness of each day and in the relationships of each insignificant personal encounter of human experience.

The focus of our Christmas celebration revolves around two unknown, simple, and ordinary people, and a child whose very birth screams destitution, rejection, condemnation, fear and violence... Three people who are prepared to put their plans into the hands of God and accept God's plan for them, with absolute trust and unwavering faith. Three people who confronted life each day with the total conviction that God was with them, in the most insignificant, ordinary and troublesome event of their daily routine.

... As we move into another year, may we grow in this awareness of the active and eternal presence of God in our lives through those with whom we are called to share life and love. Like Mary and Joseph, may we have the wisdom and the courage to accept God's presence in our lives, through the ordinary boredom of each day, through the members of our own family and all those with whom we share life and love, and through the unexpected and unplanned events that the new year may have in store for us.
