REGISTERING AT MASS

In line with government requirements and in preparation for our Christmas masses, we have created a QR code system for 'checking in' to mass. Each church has a unique code which



must be used each mass time you attend mass. There are posters with the QR code at the entrance to each church and extra copies that can be taken to the pews to check in family members. Each person must be checked in separately. If you hover your phone camera over the QR code, a link will appear at the top (usually) of your phone. Click it and it will take you to the check-in screen (as here). There will be monitors at the entrance to assist. If you do not have a phone you must sign in on the sheets provided.
